This Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program application period is ONLY FROM OCTOBER 1 TO NOVEMBER 30, 2006

What Is This Application?

This is an application to the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program starting in **Fall 2007**. There is a fee for the application to the University. For more information about the BSN program, please read the information on the School of Nursing website at <u>www.nursing.sfsu.edu</u>.

What Does It Cost?

There is **no fee** for submitting this *School of Nursing Admission Application*. For information on fees and form of payment for the <u>Undergraduate Admission Application</u>, review the San Francisco State University (SFSU) tuition fees at <u>www.sfsu.edu</u>

Who Should Use This Application?

To use this application, you **must** meet the following requirements:

- 1) California Resident.
- 2) An ALL COLLEGE TOTAL GPA of 2.8 or higher at the time of this application.
- 3) All nursing prerequisites completed with a minimum of a C grade. You may repeat prerequisites until you receive a grade of C or better; however, repeats decrease your overall competitiveness.
- 4) Applicant may have ONLY ONE of the EIGHT nursing prerequisites in progress during Spring 2007.
- 5) Completion of General Education Basic Subjects and Additional Nursing Prerequisite courses by the end of Spring 2007 semester/quarter:

General Education Basic Subjects Written Communication Oral Communication Critical Thinking Quantitative Reasoning – *Statistic*

Additional Nursing prerequisites Course Title Anatomy with Lab Physiology with Lab Chemistry with Lab General Microbiology with Lab

- 6) In addition to selection by GPA in the prerequisites, the following supplemental criteria will be considered for admission to the major and clinical courses:
 - A) Foreign language proficiency
 - B) Multicultural work/ volunteer experience
 - C) Health related work/ volunteer experience

All supplemental criteria supporting documentation must be on formal organizational letterhead stationery.

In recent years, students admitted to the major have earned an average prerequisite course GPA of 3.7 or higher, <u>and</u> 2 or more supplemental criteria were supported.

DO Not Use This Application If You...

- 1) Are NOT a California Resident.
- 2) Will not have an ALL COLLEGE TOTAL GPA of 2.8 or higher at the time of this application.
- 3) Have completed at least one of the nursing prerequisites with a grade below a minimum of a C grade.
- 4) Will not complete all nursing prerequisites by the end of Spring 2007 semester/ quarter.
- 5) Will have two or more nursing prerequisites in progress during Spring 2007 semester/ quarter.
- 6) Have a previous Bachelor's degree.
- 7) Are licensed as a Registered Nurse.

What do I Send with My Application?

TRANSFER STUDENTS

Beginning October 1 through November 30, 2006 you must submit two separate applications to SFSU: 1) BSN admissions application and 2) SFSU Admission application.

1) The BSN admission application must be submitted to the nursing department in one packet with the following items:

- 1) Completed application for admission to the Nursing Program.
- 2) All supplemental criteria supporting documentation must be on *formal organizational letterhead stationery*.
- 3) One self addressed, stamped envelope for Confirmation of Receipt of Nursing Application.

(Please cut the bottom portion of the checklist and place it inside the self addressed, stamped envelope. Please see checklist.) You will not receive a confirmation of receipt of nursing application if you do not submit a self addressed, stamped envelope.

2) SFSU admission applications must be submitted online. Please visit the CSU mentor website at <u>www.csumentor.edu</u>

You must submit official transcripts to the <u>Undergraduate Admissions office</u> to confirm all course grades taken up until the end of Fall 2006 by February 1, 2007. It is your responsibility to confirm your SFSU admissions status with the Undergraduate Admissions office.

- 1) Completed application for admission to the Nursing Program.
- 2) All supplemental criteria supporting documentation must be on *formal organizational letterhead stationery*.
- 3) One self addressed, stamped envelope for *Confirmation of Receipt of Nursing Application*. (Please cut the bottom portion of the checklist and place it inside the self addressed, stamped envelope.)
 You will not receive a confirmation of receipt of nursing application if you do not submit a self addressed, stamped envelope.

If you have taken course(s) outside of SFSU, you must submit official transcripts to the <u>Undergraduate Admissions office</u>. Official transcripts to show proof of **Fall 2006 grades** are due to the Undergraduate Admission office by **February 1, 2007**.
